And in addition, we give you a practice cruise exercise to do.

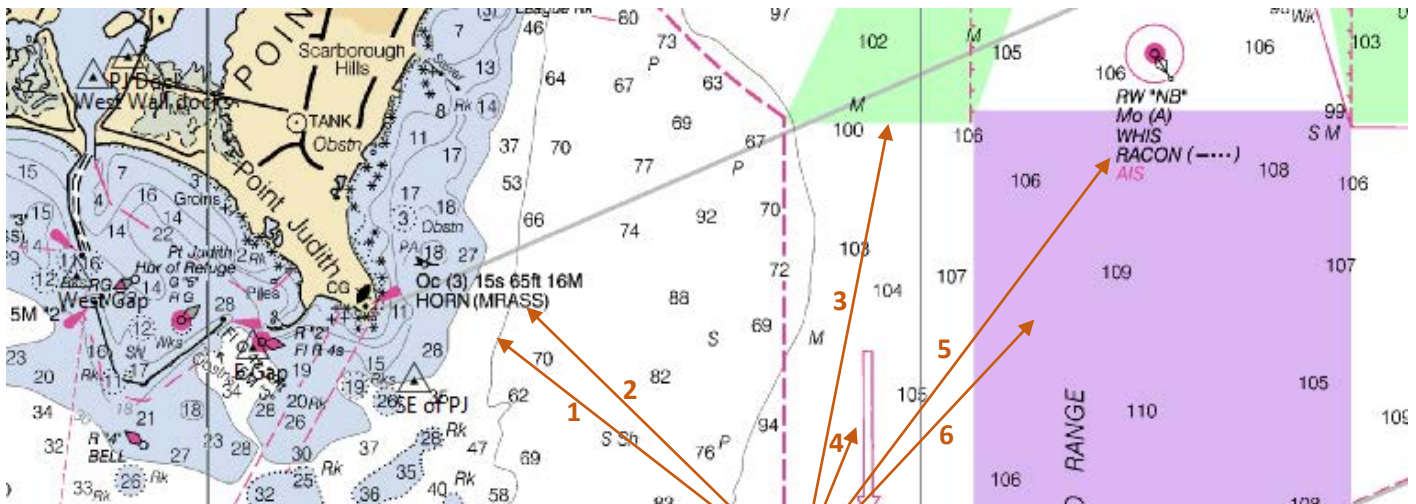
Part Two Sept. 8th to Nov. 17th Tuesday's 7pm to 9:20PM ~ Adv. Nav.
